

DUNKERY BEACON COUNTRY HOUSE - GUIDELINES FOR DOG OWNERS

We are delighted that you have come to stay with us and brought your dog/s. We love dogs with all their little foibles but are conscious that the majority of our guests do not have pets. We would respectfully ask that you take the following guidelines into account during your stay.

Inside the Hotel:

- 🐾 Dogs are allowed in the hall, stairs and your room but not in the public lounge, dining room or restaurant. Please keep your dog on a lead in the hall and on the stairs.
- 🐾 Please ensure that someone is with your dog when you are in the hotel. At mealtimes we request that you leave your dog in your car or in a crate in the living room of your suite.
- 🐾 We ask that dogs stay on the floor in your room. If you think it is likely that they may jump up onto the furnishings, then please cover the bed and the sofa (covers available to borrow on request).

Outside the Hotel:

- 🐾 Dogs must be kept on a lead and are allowed on the verandah, in the drive, car park and the grass between the side of the hotel and the car park (within the arc of planted saplings – the grass outside this area belongs to our neighbours).
- 🐾 Please clear up after your dog (bags are available on request.) A bin is available and located on the verandah.
- 🐾 Towels may be left in the shoe rack in the porch (also available to borrow if required).

We are confident that you and your pet will take care of our property. In the unlikely event of an accident, then we are sure you understand that we would have to make a charge for any damage/extra cleaning involved.

We hope that you and your dog really enjoy your stay with us. If there are any difficulties at all please do alert us and we will try to sort out any problems.
